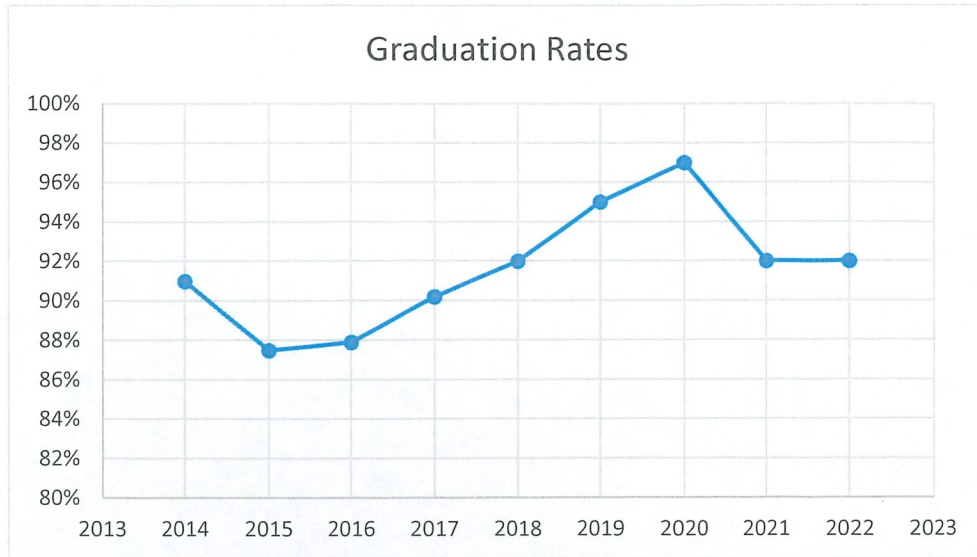

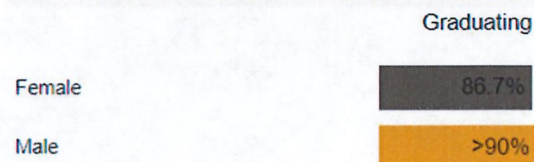

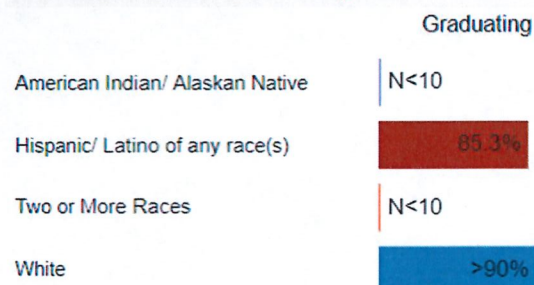

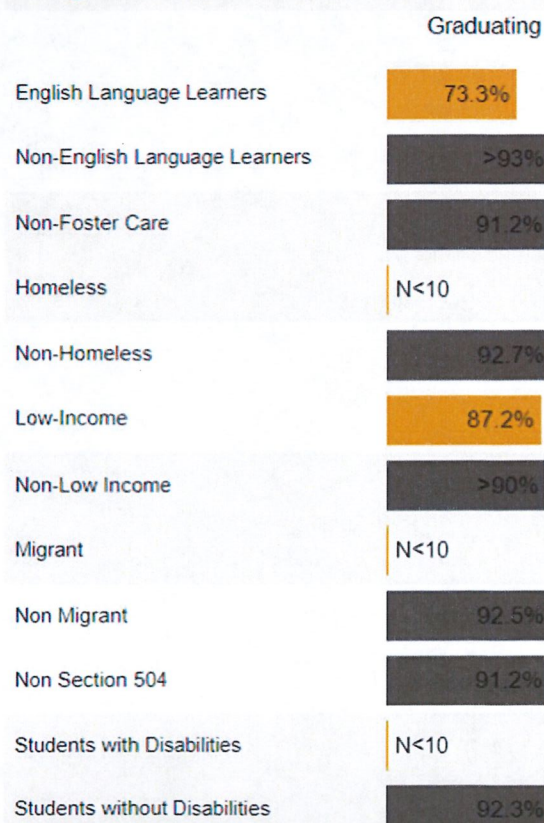
Gender



Federal Race/Ethnicity



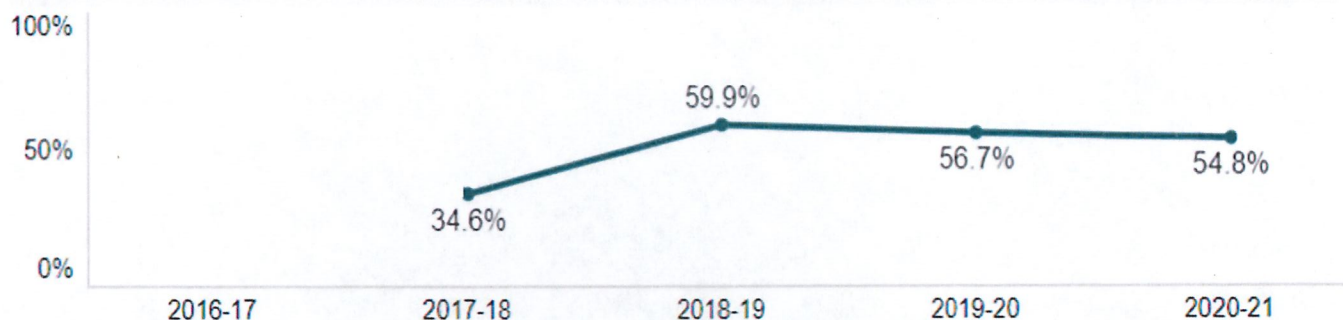

What percent of high school students completed a dual credit course, over time?

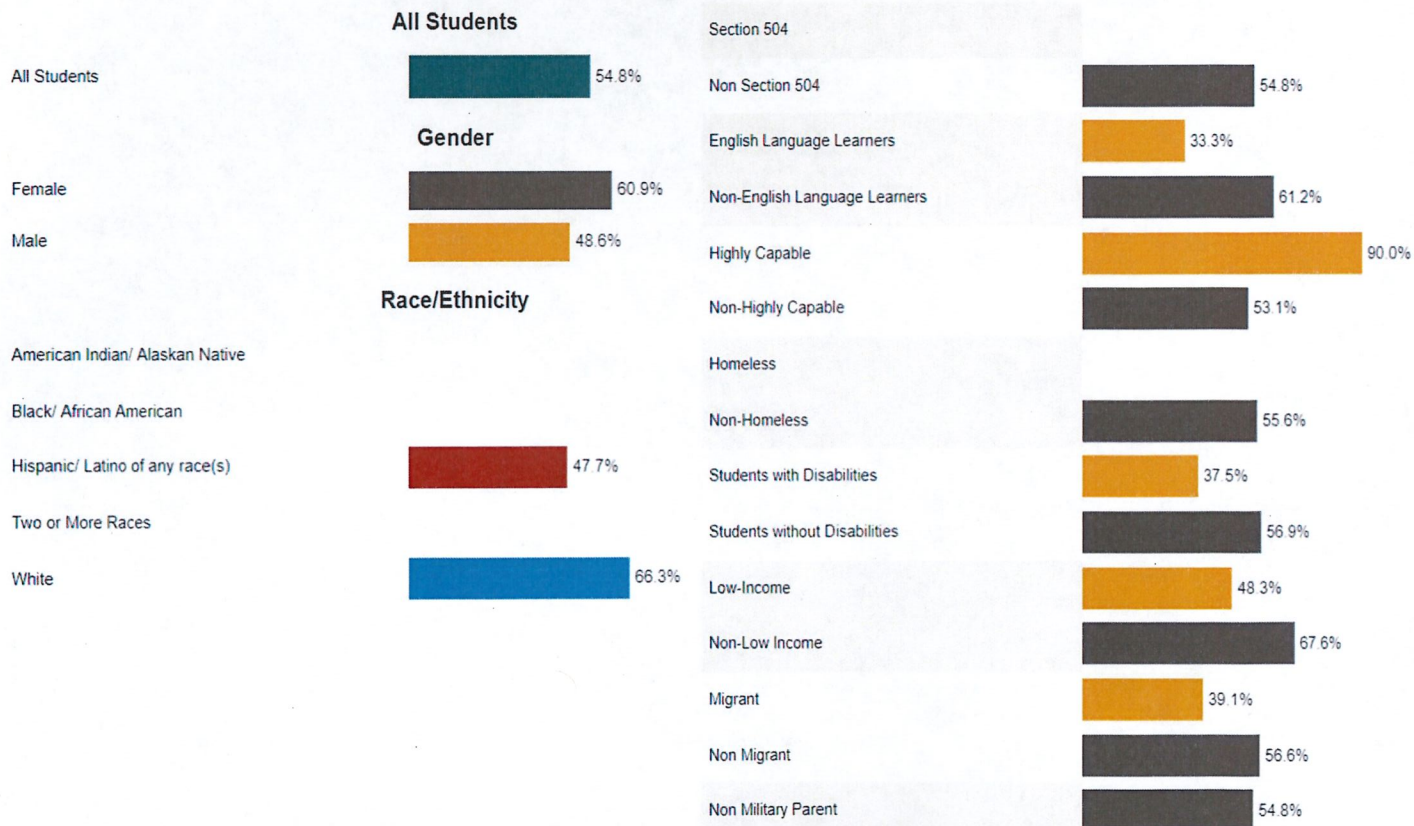

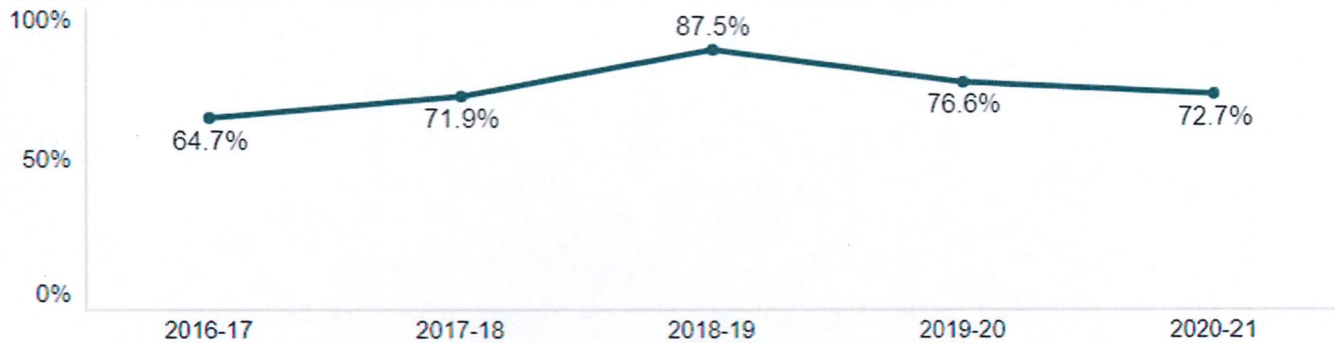

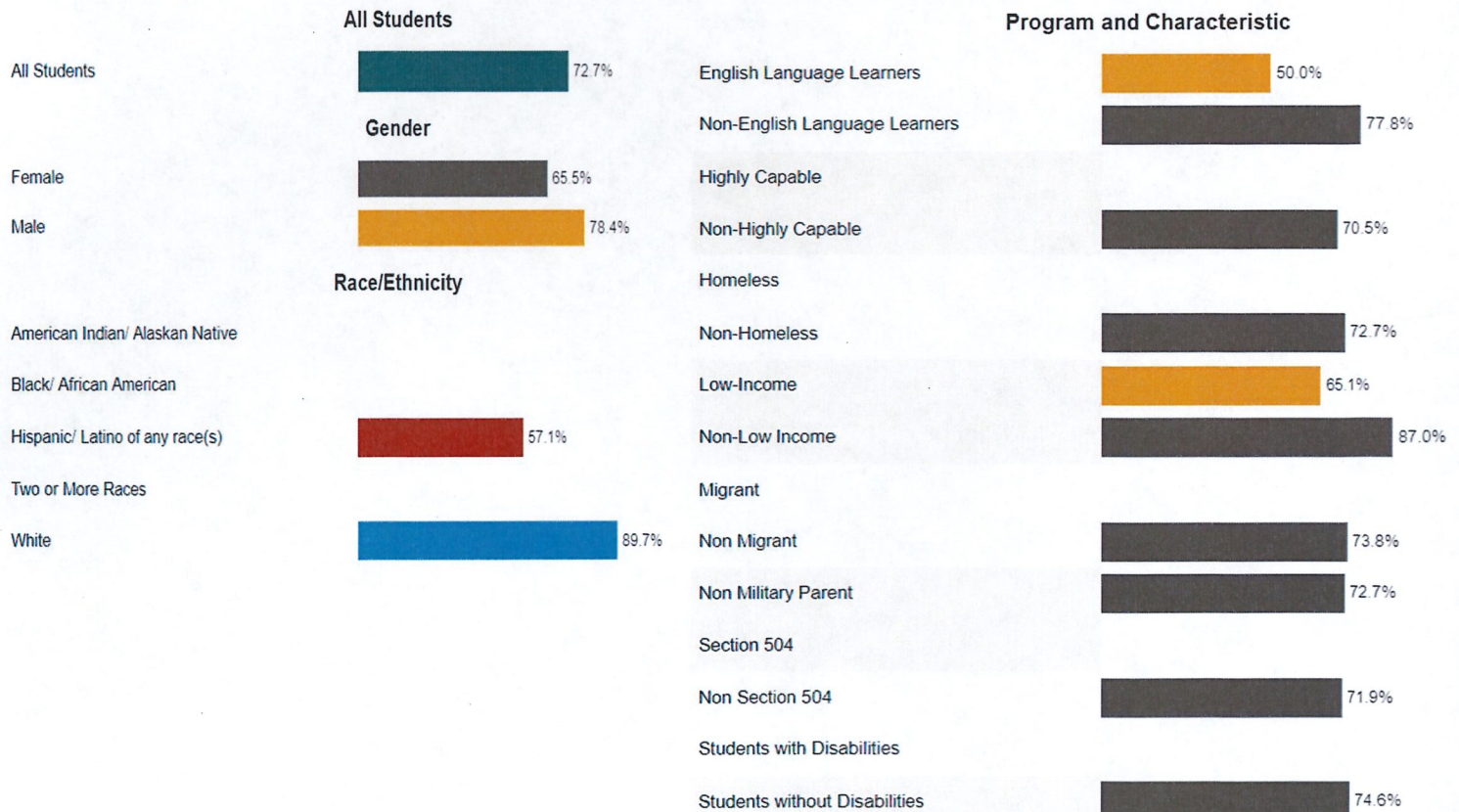
What percent of students passed all their courses in ninth grade over time?

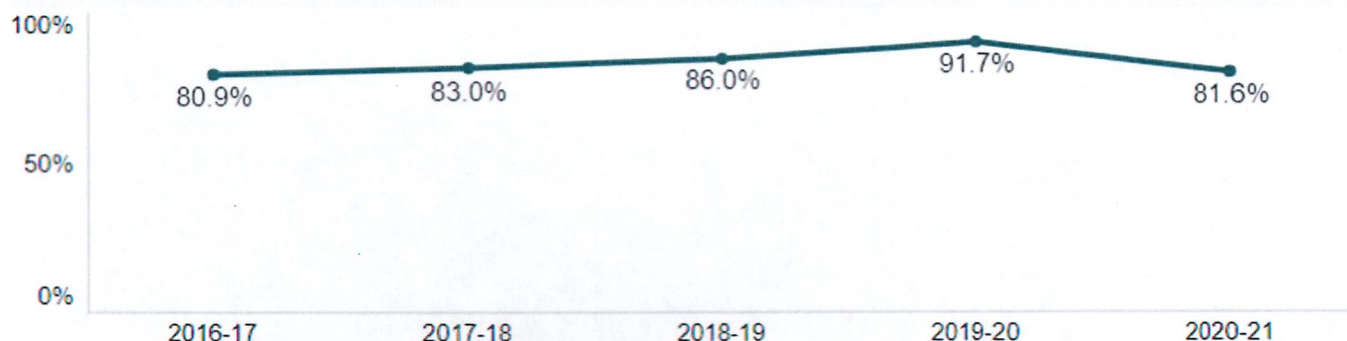

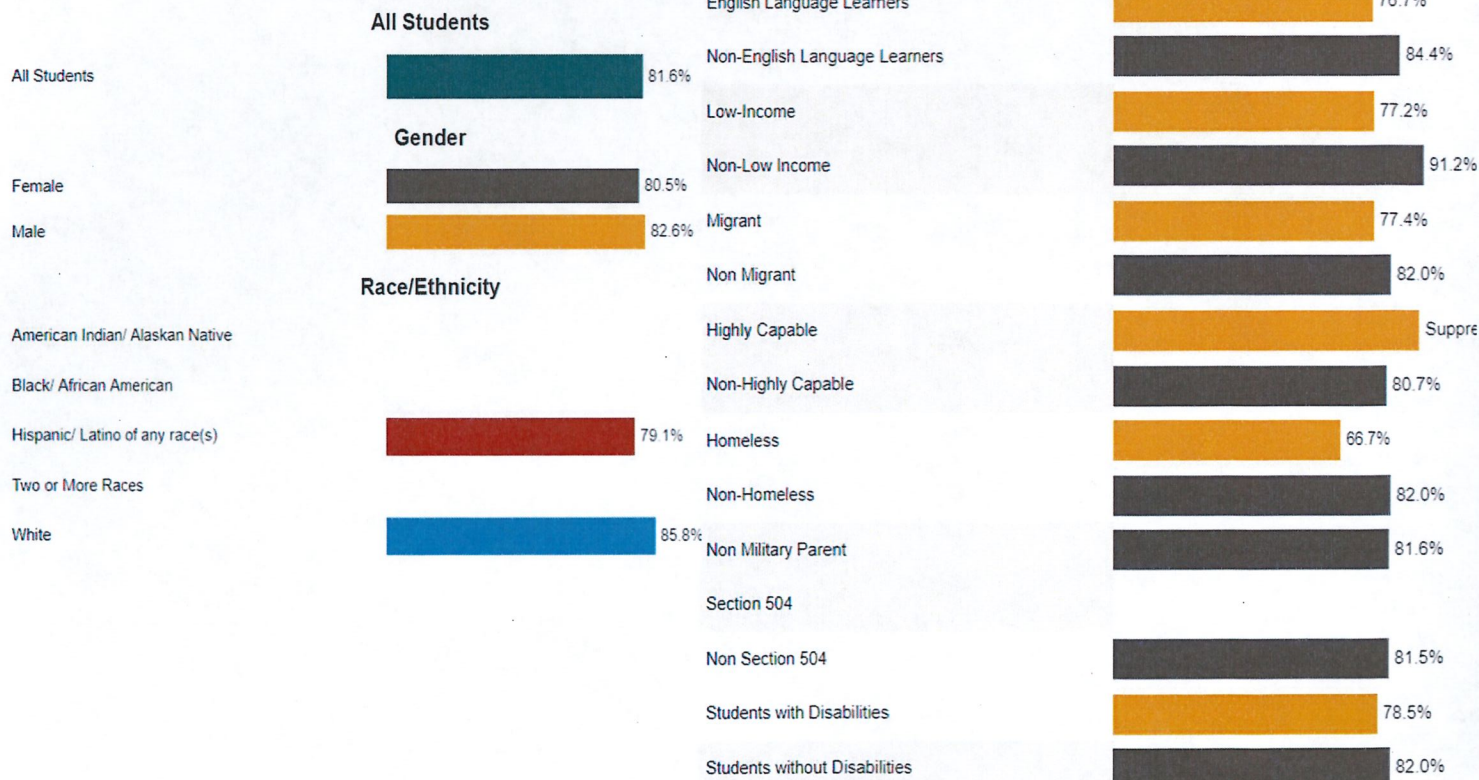
