POLICY TYPE: EXECUTIVE EXPECTATIONS

POLICY TITLE: INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

The Superintendent shall maintain a program of instruction that offers equitable, personalized, and challenging learning experiences for all students to achieve at levels defined in the Board's ***Ends*** policies.

The Superintendent will:

- 1.Ensure that instructional programs are based on a comprehensive and objective review of effective practices.
- 2.Base instruction on district adopted standards and frameworks that meet or exceed state and/or nationally-recognized model standards.
- 3.Align curriculum and resources with the standards.
- 4.Effectively measure each student's progress toward achieving or exceeding the standards.
- 5.Ensure that the instructional program includes opportunities for students to develop talents and interests in their areas of interest.
- 6.Ensure that the instructional program accommodates and personalizes learning to meet the needs of students of various backgrounds, cultures and abilities.
- 7.Encourage new and innovative programs, carefully monitoring and evaluating the effectiveness of all such programs at least annually.
- 8.Regularly evaluate and modify all instructional programs as necessary to assure their viability and continuing effectiveness.
9. Appropriately review instructional materials upon formal request by a parent or other stakeholder.
10. Adequately monitor and control student access to and utilization of electronically distributed information.

11. Provide equitable access to and utilization of district technology, resources and information.
12. Review school attendance boundaries periodically to assure reasonable balance in student enrollment.
