

POLICY TYPE: EXECUTIVE LIMITATIONS

POLICY TITLE: GENERAL EXECUTIVE ETHICS

The Manson School District's Board has a multifaceted approach to governance of risk. One of the primary components to this approach is the use of executive boundaries, which are outlined in Executive Limitations Policies and which are instructive to the Superintendent. These policies address the major areas of enterprise-wide risk and identify the Board's risk tolerance in each of these risk subject areas.

The Superintendent shall not cause or allow any practice, procedure, decision, condition, or operation that:

- Is imprudent or unlawful,
- Is in violation of commonly accepted business and professional ethics,
- Is inconsistent with Board values,
- Puts the organization at unreasonable risk,
- Leaves the organization unprepared for emergency situations,
- Is a conflict of interest.
